The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the FIR No.113 dated 19.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 406/420 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Rohtak, District Rohtak and all consequential proceedings arising thereto.

None appears on behalf of the petitioner even on second call.

The learned counsel for the State informs the Court that the petitioner is a resident of Australia and a Look Out Circular has been issued against him. He contends that there are two other FIRs against the petitioner bearing FIR No.129 dated 02.04.2019 under Sections 420, 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Kurukshetra University and FIR No.442/19 under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Mundka, Delhi. He further contends that on account of the petitioner absconding, the investigation has not even begun in the present case.

In view of the above, I find no merit in the present petition and the same is, therefore, dismissed.
