This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.71 dated 23.06.2017, registered under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 29.08.2018, notice of motion was issued by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court. Thereafter, on 18.01.2019 as well as on 01.03.2019, no body appeared on behalf of the petitioner and the case was dismissed for non-prosecution by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court. On 19.03.2019, an application was moved for recalling of the said order and the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court had allowed the said application, subject to

payment of Rs.5,000/- as costs and the present petition has been ordered to be restored to its original number.

On 04.03.2022, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner and the case was adjourned for today. Today again, no body has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Keeping in view of the above-said facts and circumstances, the present petition is dismissed. However, the liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition, in case, the compromise is still subsists and the parties are ready to give their statements before the trial Court.
