The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.150 dated 15.05.2021 registered at Police Station Sector-6, Bahadurgarh, under Sections 272, 273, 420, 120-B IPC and Sections 63 and 65 of Copy Right Act, 1957.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI Vijay Pal, from above-said police station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 19.07.2021 as passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other criminal case of the similar nature and the Challan has already been presented in the Court.

In view of the afore-said submission as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner by this Court vide the said order dated 19.07.2021, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
