The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.202 dated 23.09.2021 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC and (Sections 325 and 308 IPC, 1860 added later on) at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 28.07.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bikkar Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
