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VIVEK PURI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 for protection of life and liberty as she is apprehending danger at the instance of respondent Nos. 4 to 12.

In the status report by way of affidavit of Ranjit Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Nawanshahr, SBS Nagar, it has been specifically and categorically mentioned as follows:-

“That during inquiry of application-complaint bearing no. 1381-PTM dated 16.05.2022 both the parties were called and as both the parties have entered into compromise and as the petitioner Rajni Bala suffered statement that "she do not want to proceed with the application-complaint moved by her", hence the application-complaint bearing no. 1381-PTM dated 16.05.2022 moved by the petitioner recommended to file in record room. Now no application-complaint is pending and hence there is no question of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner from her in-laws and relatives.

Additional Plea:

That today on 26-07-2022 the Station House Officer (respondent No.3) himself visited the house of Rajni Bala and

verified about the aspect of threats to her life and liberty from her in-laws & relatives. Rajni Bala in the presence of Avtar Singh son of Jhalman Singh resident of village Ranewal PS Rahon made a statement to me in which she has stated that the terms and conditions of the compromise 31-05-2022 were not honored by the respondent No.4 to 12. She further stated that she has filed cases which are pending before the Hon'ble courts at Nawanshahr and till no decision is made in those cases, I will be residing in my in-law's house. The respondent No.3 did not find any apprehension to her life and liberty at the place of her residence as she is residing alone and respondent No.4 to 12 are residing separately in a different house.”

In view of the aforesaid, no further action is called for in the matter.
