This is an application for vacation of stay on disbursement of amount of benefit to respondent No.1.

The counsel for the parties have not disputed the fact that the necessary experience certificate stands granted to respondent No.1.

In view of the above, the present application has been rendered infructuous and disposed of as such.

Main Case

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari or

any other writ, direction or order in the nature thereof seeking quashing/setting aside the orders dated 28.04.2021 (Annexure P-12) passed by respondent No.2, whereby the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 27.10.2020 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent No.3 has been dismissed and order dated 27.10.2020 has been upheld; with a further prayer to quash the order dated 27.10.2020, whereby the petitioner has been directed to pay maternity benefits to respondent No.1, with certain another prayer made in the present petition.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has since been amicably settled between the parties.

The factum of compromise is not even disputed by the counsel for respondent No.1. However, the counsel for respondent No.1 submits that some amount was ordered to be deposited with the registry of this Court. The said amount deserves to be released in favour of respondent No.1 as per the compromise. Hence, the same be released to respondent No.1.

In view of the above stands taken by the parties, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous in terms of the compromise arrived at between the parties. The amount which was deposited with the registry of this Court; pursuant to the order dated 17.06.2021, is ordered to be released to respondent No.1 against proper receipt.
