Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Mr. Karanbir Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, points out that the statements of Balwinder Singh son of Bakshish, Gurmukh Singh son of Balwinder Singh and Paramjit Kaur wife of Balwinder Singh, who are private respondents in the instant petition and are family members of the petitioner, have already been recorded, wherein they have specifically stated that they have no objection to the girl (petitioner) staying at her own and that she has no threat from the private respondents.

The aforesaid statements have been recorded on 30.05.2022 and have been shown in Court today. Let a photocopy of the same be handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner and the original one be returned to the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not intend to press the instant petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
