FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The applicant/wife-Suneha has come up in this application under Section 24 of CPC seeking transfer of a petition bearing No.DMC/2128/2021 titled as 'Tajinder Kumar versus Suneha' filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the Court of the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court-II, Jalandhar to the competent Court at Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

The primary ground that has been canvassed is the inability of the wife to contest the litigation because of the distance and that she has to earn her livelihood.

Heard counsel for the parties and perused the records.

Admittedly, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar was carved out of the erstwhile Jalandhar District and are two adjoining districts hardly the distance between the abode of the petitioner and of the Courts, is around 25 KMs, not much of a distance and that too, when both the places are situated on the main GT road well connected with all types of conveyance available throughout the day. What transpires from the submissions of the counsel for the petitioner it was purely on receipt of process of the Court issued on 14.03.2022 intimating next date of hearing as 25.05.2022, the application has come about is suggestive of the applicants' ploy to ensure that the husband is not able to pursue his litigation. Such like applications have become quite common by the wives ensuring to take undue sympathies of the Court being a woman. It needs to be kept in mind that in the process of dispensation of justice, the Courts need not discriminate between the two sexes. Apparently, there are nothing compelling circumstance enough to ensure cognizance of the application and there are no valid reasons and grounds so set up, the application on the face of it, being devoid of merits, stands dismissed in limine.
