Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to appoint the petitioner in Government Service along with all consequential benefits as per Policy dated 08.11.2011, amended vide Guidelines dated 28.02.2014/03.03.2014 (P-4). Further prayer is for directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the Legal Notice dated 17.04.2022 (P-10).

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 17.04.2022 (P-10) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the aforesaid Legal Notice dated 17.04.2022 (P-10) by passing speaking order as per law within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
