Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even after the dismissal of the petitioner from service on account of the conviction by the criminal Court where the petitioner has been given death penalty, the respondents were under an obligation to give the petitioner, pension for the period the petitioner had served with the respondents despite being dismissed from service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P-5), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. S.K. Sharma, Senior Standing Counsel, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-UOI and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the representation, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 26.10.2021 (Annexure P-5), by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
