1. This petition was filed seeking directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of the respondents and for transfer the investigation of case FIR No 16, dated 27th February, 2022, under Section 307, 326-A, 148, 149 IPC and later on converted into 302, 148 and 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur and FIR No 66, dated 9th May, 2022, under Section 7 of PC Act, 1988, at Police Station City-1, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from DSP Bharpur Singh submits that the proceedings have been initiated for handing over the investigation of FIR No. 66, dated 9th May, 2022, under Section 7 of PC Act, 1988, at Police Station City-1, Sangrur, District Sangrur to the Vigilance Bureau. He on instructions further submits that the investigation

with regard to FIR No. 16 would be given to Bureau of Investigation and FIR would not be dealt with by the officials posted at police Station Khanauri.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

4. Petitioners are present in the Court, duly identified by learned counsel for the petitioner and they no longer want to stay in protection home.

5. The petitioners as an interim measure were kept in shelter house, Chandigarh and they may be permitted to leave the protection home as per their wish.

6. The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
