[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings
against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order,
Annexure P-1, dated 14.08.2018, in CWP No.1904 of 1999 in case titled as
'Mal Singh versus State of Punjab and another'.

[2] Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 17.10.2019,
COCP No.1529 of 2019 was disposed of with a direction that in case, the
petitioner deposited an amount of Rs.7.68 lacs within one week, needful
for transferring the plot would be done.

[3] Learned counsel contends that on failure of the respondents
to do the needful, an application was moved for revival of the instant
petition but now the respondents have transferred the plot in favour of the
petitioner, though by incorporating a condition raising a demand for non-

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to pursue the matter with the respondents *qua* the demand for non-construction charges and if need be to take out appropriate proceedings in respect thereto, in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
