Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.84, dated 04.03.2022, under Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Punhana, District Nuh.

This Court vide order dated 17.05.2022 while noticing the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner issued notice of motion for today. In the meanwhile, it was directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/ Investigating Officer subject to the conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. The petitioner was directed to join investigation and co-operate with the Investigating Agency as and when required.

Today, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, pursuant to the order passed by this Court on 17.05.2022.

Learned State counsel, on instructions received from S.I. Digvijay Singh, states that the petitioner in fact did join the investigation on 11.08.2022 and the recovery of the country made pistol was also effected from him.

Learned State counsel further submits that the petitioner is not required any more for custodial interrogation at this stage.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that in case the Investigating Agency requires the petitioner to appear, he shall make himself available without any demur.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioner is allowed and the order dated 17.05.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute, subject to compliance of conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
