The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.33 dated 21.02.2021 under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

As per report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Center to which the parties were referred to, they have amicably settled their dispute.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have also filed a petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 wherein their first motion statements have been recorded.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant does not dispute the submissions made by counsel opposite. He also does not oppose the prayer made by leaned counsel for the petitioner for grant of

anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, has submitted that in compliance of order dated 15.06.2021, the petitioner has joined investigation and he is no longer required by the investigating agency for further investigation much less custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 15.06.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
