GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.168 dated 29.10.2019 registered at Police Station mataur, District SAS Nagar under Sections 279/427 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 30.07.2021, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SAS Nagar, Mohali, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioner, namely, Vishaldeep Sharma as

well as of complainant Gagandeep have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Gagandeep in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SAS Nagar, Mohali, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise without any coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.168 dated 29.10.2019 registered at Police Station mataur, District SAS Nagar under Sections 279/427 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
