While granting interim protection to the petitioner on 17.05.2022,
this Court passed the following order:-

“Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.127 dated 02.08.2018, registered for offences under Sections 354, 323, 341 and 511 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Division 2, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana (Annexure P-2).

Counsel for the petitioner submits that genesis of the FIR is a matrimonial dispute between the complainant and Makhan Singh, who is related to the petitioner. He has placed reliance upon interim order dated 06.05.2022 passed in CRM-M-18985-2022 (Annexure P-1), whereby co-accused, Jaswinder Singh @ Bana, who is similarly situated, has been granted interim protection by this Court.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.S.Gill, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He is assisted by Mr. Arjun Veer Sharma, Advocate for the complainant, who has filed Vakalatnama, which is taken on record. He has vehemently opposed the petition.

List on 21.09.2022.

To be heard with CRM-M-18985-2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would appear as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Upon instructions received from ASI Gurpreet Singh, learned State counsel submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

Interim order passed in the case of *Jaswinder Singh @ Bana Vs. State of Punjab in CRM-M-18985 of 2022*, has been made absolute by this Court vide an order passed on the even date.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the petition, present petition is allowed and order dated 17.05.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
