1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 16.12.2021, in CWP-25663-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-25663-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondent to take appropriate decision on pending representation/legal notice dated 04.10.2021, filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law, within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Today, learned AAG, Haryana, has filed reply/compliance report by way of affidavit of Shri Ajay Kumar, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Nuh, along with Annexure R/1 and R/2as per which payment on account of security amount was released to the petitioner on 01.06.2022 whereas interest for delay in releasing the payment was made on 27.07.2022. The reply is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to

learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
