This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of criminal complaint no.02 of 2016 instituted on 02.01.2016 titled as Smt.Anita Devi vs. Sumer Singh, under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and summoning order dated 28.01.2016 and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for respondent no.1 has stated that present petition has been rendered infructuous inasmuch the petitioner has been convicted vide judgment dated 11.01.2019. No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.
