Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of the Criminal Procedure, 1973, (for short - “the Code”) seeking issuance of direction to the respondents to conduct fair and impartial enquiry in FIR No.20 dated 26.02.2022, Annexure P-1, lodged for offence under Section 498-A of IPC at Police Station Mukandpur, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had filed FIR, Annexure P-1, against her husband as well as his relatives but the investigation was not carried out in an impartial manner and the Investigating Agency declared the relatives of the husband to be innocent. He submits that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 21.03.2022, Annexure P-2, to respondent No.2, which is not being attended to.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Having heard counsel for the parties, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SBS Nagar - respondent No.2 to examine the representation, Annexure P-2, and to take suitable action thereon, as warranted in accordance with law.
