This is a petition that has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari, for quashing the impugned revised final result dated 28.02.2022 (Annexure P-7) for the posts of Sub-Inspector (Female), which were advertised vide advertisement No.3/2021 dated 15.06.2021 (Annexure P-1) to the extent the roll number of the petitioner does not find mentioned therein.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that respondents be directed to treat the instant writ petition as representation on behalf of the petitioner and the same be decided expeditiously. He would submit that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a decision is taken on the representation in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to official respondents only.

Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice for the official respondents and submits that the official

respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner. Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without going into merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to treat the instant writ petition as the representation of the petitioner and decide the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
