This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 468, dated 28.12.2019, registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under the provisions of Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Though learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 02 years with the quantity of contraband alleged to have been recovered from the petitioner being marginally above commercial quantity, learned Additional Public Prosecutor U.T. Chandigarh, on instructions from ASI Sher Singh, submits that as a matter of fact the trial has virtually concluded with only one prosecution witness left to be examined and the next date of hearing being tomorrow.

That being so, I see no ground to entertain this petition, which is consequently dismissed, with no comment made on the actual merits of the case.
