Main case

Instant appeal has been filed under Section 14-A (2) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 impugning order dated 04.05.2022 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Rupnagar, vide which an application for anticipatory bail, has been dismissed.

State counsel submits that pursuant to order dated 16.05.2022 passed by this Court, appellants have joined the investigation and have cooperated with the investigation. Still further, upon instructions, he submits that challan has been presented qua the appellants.

In view of the above, but without examining the merits of the case, appeal is allowed. Impugned order dated 04.05.2022 is set aside. Interim order dated 16.05.2022 is made absolute, subject to conditions laid down under Section 438 (2), Cr.P.C.
