Present appeal has been filed against the order dated 04.05.2022 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge (Special Court for Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes, Prevention of Atrocities) Act, Kurukshetra vide which anticipatory bail of the petitioner in case FIR No.156 dated 19.03.2022, under Sections 354, 354-A, 506, 509 IPC and Section 3 of SC/ST Act, registered at Police Station K.U.K has been declined.

Vide order dated 19.05.2022 while granting interim protection, the appellant was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that pursuant to order dated 19.05.2022, appellant has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the appellant.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that the appellant has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 19.05.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Appeal stands allowed.
