Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.0014 dated 25.01.2022 registered under Sections 323, 377, 498-A and 506 IPC and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Women Police Station, district Yamuna Nagar.

Since at this stage the investigation in the impugned FIR is still pending learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the concerned Investigating Officer to examine the issues raised in the present petition before filing of any report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, who appears on advance notice, has no objection if the above alternate prayer is accepted.

At this stage of the proceedings the alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioners is found to be reasonable and accordingly, the

present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Investigating Officer who is investigating the FIR in question to objectively go through the issues raised in the present petition before he files any report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.
