[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 02.11.2018 in RFA No.4115 of 2003.

[2] Learned AAG has produced compliance report dated 21.11.2022 along with CC Form reflecting payment of Rs.1,13,647/-, 1,13,647, 1,13,646 and 1,13,646 to the petitioners i.e. Asha Bhandralia wife of Vijay Kumar, Vishal Singh son of Vijay Kumar, Deepika Rana daughter of Vijay Kumar and Archana Bhandralia wife of Suresh Singh respectively in terms of entitlement in LAC case award No.119 dated 30.09.1998. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioners to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law for claiming the statutory benefits wherever the same have not been released in terms of the release order, Annexure P/1.

[4] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
