Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 19.12.2012, vide which respondent Nos. 1 to 8 have been granted the concession of bail by the trial Court in case FIR No. 166 dated 06.06.2007, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B of the IPC at Police Station DLF Phase-II, Gurgaon (now Gurugram).

Respondent Nos. 1 to 8 were granted the concession of bail on 19.12.2012 by the trial Court and since then, a period of more than 09 years has lapsed, however, there is no allegation that they have either misused the same or have ever tried to influence any witness or have extended any threat to the complainant. Therefore, after such a long period, there is no justification to cancel the bail at this stage and that too in the absence of any specific allegation.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
