On 23.06.2021 following order was passed:-

“ Case has been heard through video conferencing on
account of Covid-19 Pandemic.

*This is a case where a married woman (petitioner No.1)
is presently living with some other person (petitioner No.2)
and both of them are seeking protection to their lives and
liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 8 which also
includes her husband-Ranjit Singh.*

*At this stage, notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3
only for 12.8.2021.*

Mr. P.S. Walia, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of

respondents No.1 to 3.

In the meantime, respondent No.2 is to look into the matter and to act in accordance with law, in case, he finds any threat perception to petitioner No.1 from the side of her in-laws.”

The reply of ACP, Industrial Area, Ludhiana has been filed on dated 10.08.2021. The statement of the petitioner no.1 has been annexed with the reply which shows that she does not face any threat from anyone including her parental or in-laws family. This fact has been endorsed by petitioner no.2 as well.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are required to be passed.
