Status report by way of affidavit of Gurdeep Singh Gosal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jagraon, Police District Ludhiana (Rural) on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 has been filed. The same is taken on record.

2. As per the status report, it has been submitted that:-

“xx xx xx

Enquiry on the said application was marked to the S.P. (HQ), Ludhiana (Rural) and in connection with the enquiry, the son of the petitioner namely Ashish Bhatia was called as envisaged u/s 160 Cr.P.C. but he failed to join the enquiry. During the enquiry, one victim Sukhwinder Singh stated that an amount of Rs.1.25 Lac was also paid by him to the present petitioner and accordingly the present petitioner was joined in the enquiry and her statement was also recorded on 24.08.2018 by the S.P. (HQ) during which no offence was made out against the present petitioner but commission of offence was made out against the son of

the petitioner and his accomplices. Accordingly FIR No.261 dated 27.9.2018 u/s 420, 406 IPC, P.S. City Jagraon has been registered against the said son of the petitioner and his accomplices for cheating those six persons under the garb of sending them abroad. The son of the petitioner is still absconding in the said FIR. Thus, all these false allegations have been levelled in anticipation to pressurize the police not to take any action against the petitioner and her son. There is no threat to the petitioner from the complainants of the FIR. Even the alleged representation dated 20.08.2018 Annexure P-1 was never moved by the petitioner with respondent no.2 and the name has been falsely mentioned just to make out a false ground to file the present petition.”

3. In view of the stand taken by the State, nothing survives in the present petition to be adjudicated at the hands of this Court. Consequently, the same is disposed off as having been rendered infructuous.
