Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to register an FIR under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC read with Section 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sector-53, Gurugram, Haryana, in view of the provisions of Section 154 Cr.P.C. on the basis of a complaint dated 07.08.2020 (Annexure P-1) already filed by the petitioner to respondent Nos. 2 and 3.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner confines his arguments to the effect that the petitioner would be satisfied, if her complaint/representation dated 07.08.2020 (Annexure P-1) is decided by the competent authority of District Gurugram within a stipulated period.
