The petitioner seeks quashing of the FIR No.16 dated 23.01.2019 under Sections 406/420/120-B/465/467/468/471 IPC (Sections 465/467/468/471 IPC added vide DDR No.43 dated 21.01.2020) registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (Annexure P1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner with the averment that no cognizable offence is disclosed to have been committed by the petitioner and, therefore, the same will be an abuse of process of law.

However, today, learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed for withdrawal of the present petition, with liberty to take all pleas, as taken in

the present petition, before the revisional court, during the course of hearing,
which is pending qua framing of charges.

Prayer is allowed.
