[1] Learned counsel states that in view of the petitioner's daughter who was petitioner in CRWP No.3689 of 2022 having been produced before the concerned SSP / SP who in turn produced her before the Child Welfare Committee in terms of order, Annexure P/1 dated 22.04.2022 in CRWP No.3689 of 2022, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to make his submissions qua the allegations raised against him by his minor daughter, before the Child Welfare Committee, for passing appropriate orders.

[2] In view of the position noted above, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
