AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed seeking directions to the official respondents to decide representation dated 23.6.2020 and take appropriate action against the private respondents in FIR No. 145 dated 24.5.2020, under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 3(1)(s) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala.

The State filed status report dated 11.2.2021. As per the status report, the investigation of the FIR is at final stage, report was submitted by Superintendent of Police Traffic, Patiala, the same has been examined by Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala. Directions were issued by Senior Superintendent of Police for taking necessary action. Opinion of District Attorney, Patiala was sought and thereafter it was concluded that no separate FIR needs to be registered but necessary offences have been enhanced in the report.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in spite of conclusion of the investigation, the grievance still survives.

In view of the status report filed and that investigation of the FIR is at final stage, no further directions are called for in the present petition.

The petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance, if any.
