Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.160 dated 11.04.2022 registered under Section 346 IPC at Police Station Sirsa Sadar, District Sirsa.

Since investigation in the case is still going on, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage he would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Investigating Officer in the aforesaid FIR to consider the averments made in the present petition before finalizing the investigation in the FIR in question.
