In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner was working as a Laboratory Attendant on contract basis and her services were dispensed with on joining of the regular incumbents though, the post was still available for her adjustment keeping in view the work load.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that similarly situated employees, who were also relieved from service on joining of regular incumbents, have already been extended the relief being claimed by the petitioner in the present petition keeping in view the order passed by the respondents on 18.08.2022. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner be also treated in the similar fashion and be granted the same

relief as being granted to the similarly situated employees vide order dated 18.08.2022.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the petitioner files any representation placing reliance upon the order dated 18.08.2022, her claim will also be considered by keeping in mind the grounds raised in the said representation and appropriate order will be passed within a period of four weeks of the receipt of any such representation. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case, it is found that petitioner is also similarly situated with the employees, who have been granted relief as per the order dated 18.08.2022, the same relief will also be extended to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation.

Ordered accordingly.

As the main petition has been disposed of having been not pressed, CM No. 14471-CWP-2022 also stands disposed of having been not pressed.
