Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short “the Code”) for issuance of direction to the executing Court to expeditiously dispose of CRM/105/2019, filed under Section 128 of the Code, which is pending before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Dera Bassi, Annexure P-1.

Although, it has been urged that a direction be issued to the executing Court to decide the petition in a time bound manner, but this Court is of the view that in the post-Covid period, the Courts are over-burdened with cases and it would not be appropriate to pass any such direction. However, considering the fact that the execution petition is pending since 2016, the executing Court shall make an endeavour and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
