The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the impugned order dated 07.05.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist class, Moga in case bearing FIR No.180 dated 18.11.2016 (Annexure P-2) registered under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga being totally illegal and contrary to the provisions of Section 82 Cr.PC.

On 18.08.2022 the following order was passed:-

“ Learned Counsel contends that the petitioner was summoned under Section 319 Cr.PC as additional accused vide order dated 29.02.2020 and case was fixed by trial Court for 01.04.2020. According to him, as a result of breakout of pandemic COVID-19, summons were not effectively served upon the petitioner and thereafter, the Court has declared him proclaimed person vide order dated 07.05.2022. He states that

petitioner is willing to join the proceedings.

Notice of motion for 29.07.2022.

Let the petitioner appear before the trial Court on or before 10.06.2022 and upon his appearance, he shall be released on interim regular bail subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Court.”

The Counsel for the State on instructions submits that petitioner-Lal Chand has surrender on 25.05.2022, pursuant to which he has been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
