Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 33 dated 31.03.2022, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Dugri, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 18.05.2022, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 18.05.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
