On 31.05.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.241 dated 08.04.2022, registered for offences under Sections 498-A, 323, 354, 406 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short “IPC”) read with Section 34, IPC, at Police Station Kundli, District Sonipat, Annexure P-1.

Status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Crime, Sonipat has been filed on behalf of State-respondent, which is taken on record and has been perused.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the father-in-law of complainant-respondent No.2. Counsel contends that false allegation of trying to outrage the modesty has been levelled against the petitioner in the FIR as there is a matrimonial dispute between the petitioner's son and complainant-respondent No.2. Counsel submits that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation and cooperate with the Investigating Agency.

List on 28.09.2022.

The petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and would appear as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Upon instructions received from ASI, Sunil, State counsel submits that the petitioner, who is the father-in-law of the complainant, has joined the investigation pursuant to order dated 31.05.2022 passed by this Court. He submits that petitioner has co-operated during investigation, which has been completed. Upon further instructions, she submits that challan against the main accused stands presented and charges have been framed against him.

In view of the above, but without examining the merits of the case, present petition is allowed.

Order dated 31.05.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
