1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1 dated 01.02.2022 in CWP-608-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 01.02.2022 reveals that CWP-608-2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide the appeal preferred by the petitioner in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order .

3. Notice has yet not been issued in the instant petition. However, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent has produced copy of order dated 25.05.2022 passed by the respondent rejecting the claim by the petitioner by passing a speaking order. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and he may be permitted to

withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 25.05.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
