On the last date of hearing i.e. 17.05.2022, following order was
passed:-

“ Learned counsel for the State prays for an adjournment to seek instructions with regard to the assertion of the petitioners that the warrants of possession have been issued in pursuance to the order passed by the Collector, which is under challenge, along with an application for stay has been preferred by them, which application till date has not been decided and the Joint Development Commissioner, Mohali, has been adjourning the matter on one pretext or the other, which is the Appellate Authority.

Adjourned to 20.05.2022.

Status quo with regard to possession as it exists today

shall be maintained till the next date of hearing.”

Counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the next date of hearing fixed before the Joint Development Commissioner, Mohali is 29.06.2022.

In the light of the above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the parties to maintain status quo with regard to possession, as it existed on 17.05.2022. The said order shall continue till the decision is taken on the application for stay, which has been preferred by the petitioners, along with their appeal pending with the Joint Development Commissioner, Mohali on 29.06.2022.
