ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

Aggrieved by the directions to deposit 20% of the compensation amount for suspension of sentence till disposal of the appeal, by the learned Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, the petitioner has come up before this Court.

Given the nature of the case, the order this Court proposes to pass is that no notice is required to issue to the respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contented and satisfied if the impugned order is modified to 20% of the 'cheque amount' instead of 'compensation amount'.

Prayer is genuine and as such, it is allowed.

In the interest of justice, petition is ***disposed of*** and in the impugned order the words “20% of the compensation amount” shall be read as “20% of the cheque amount”. The said amount will be deposited on or before 16.07.2022.
