Pursuant to the previous order passed in CR-8331-2014, in favour of Thakur Dwara Saroud, which has been affirmed, by the Supreme Court in the execution petition has been revived.

Learned senior counsel representing the petitioner contends that this execution petition has been filed by a person, who have no right in the property. From a bare look at the execution petition, it is evident that it has been filed by the Thakur Dwara, Saroud through some of its representatives. These proceedings are not with respect to decision on an issue that whether someone is Chela (inheritor) of the Thakur Dwara or not. The Supreme Court in its order has already explained that the decree is in favour of the Deity, which will remain to be so.
