Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.602 dated 06.10.2021 under Sections 148, 149, 307, 506 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act (Sections 379B & 120-B IPC were added later on), registered at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of Prem Chand, six persons named in the FIR caused injuries with gun shots. It is further submitted that the petitioner caused firearm injury and he was not named in the FIR, though six persons were named giving their parentage and address, however, later on, in the disclosure statement of co-accused, name of the petitioner surfaced and he was arrested. It

is also submitted that the petitioner is in custody for the last about 04 months; investigation is complete and after his arrest, recovery of a motorcycle was effected from him.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of custody certificate filed in the Court today, has not disputed the factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
