Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though in the present petition, the challenge is to the Awards dated 28.04.2016 (Annexures P-1 to P-30) but the petitioner only restrict his prayer for deciding of his appeal cum representation dated 04.02.2017 (Anneuxre P-36) which the petitioner had filed before the Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Bathinda. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that five years have elapsed but the said appeal has not been decided so far and therefore, the respondents be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the petitioner preferred appeal cum representation dated 04.02.2017 (Anneuxre P-36) and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities even as of now, appropriate order on the said representation will be passed within a period of two months from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may be disposed of as such.
