1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 23.09.2021, in CWP-19055-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 23.09.2021, reveals that CWP-19055-2021, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider legal notice dated 26.07.2021 as a representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to the relief claimed and there was no impendent, to release the same to the petitioner without any delay as per law.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of speaking order dated 10.03.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as raised in legal notice dated 26.07.2021. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof

states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 26.07.2021, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
