The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C

To be heard along with CRM-M-19511-2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance

of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel, who is instructed by ASI Ravi Kant, states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 19.05.2022 is made absolute.
