Instant petition assails the notice of provisional attachment dated 07.01.2020 (Annexure P-8) issued by the 1st respondent i.e. Commissioner of CGST, Faridabad.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner presses for the alternate prayer i.e. for issuance of a mandamus to dispose of a grievance application dated 20.04.2022 (Annexure P-11) within a time bound manner.

Since an advance copy of the writ petition already stands served upon the respondents, Mr. Rishabh Kapoor, learned senior standing counsel has entered appearance on behalf of the respondents.

Counsel for the respondents takes a very fair stand that the grievance application filed on 20.04.2022 at Annexure P-11 would be treated as objections filed under Rule 159 (5) of the C.G. and S.T. Rules, 2017 and a final decision would be taken thereupon expeditiously and in any case within a period of six weeks from today.

Statement is accepted.

No further directions are required to be passed.

Petition stands disposed of.

It is, however, clarified that this Court has not examined the issue on merits.
