The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for issuing directions to the respondents to set aside the distance measurement shown at Sr. No.2, 13, 14 and 18 in Annexure P-4.
