Present petition has been filed seeking intervention of this Court so as to decide representation dated 26.05.2021 (Annexure P-11) wherein, the petitioner has raised a grievance that keeping in view the guidelines issued by the Ministry of Personal Public Grievance, Government of India dated 18.10.2013 as well as 18.06.2014, wherever any cognizance of the anonymous complaint is to be taken, those guidelines should be adhered to.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are anonymous complaints being filed against the petitioner and on the basis of the said allegations, petitioner has also been implicated in false and frivolous FIRs and therefore, the petitioner is being harassed unnecessarily as he is being summoned by the police authorities time and again.

Learned State counsel submits that he has instructions to submit that in case, in respect of any complaint, which has been received or will be received, involving the same allegations with regard to the preparing of the fake arms licences, petitioner will be summoned after serving appropriate notice as envisaged under Cr.P.C by giving him 07 days notice.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
