Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.27 dated 17.04.2021 registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Hathur, District Ludhiana Rural.

Since investigation in the case is still going on, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage he would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Investigating Officer in the aforesaid FIR to consider and investigate the averments made in the present petition before concluding the investigation in the FIR in question.
